This strengthens the article. 2- With respect to the content, I will present my opinion regarding the economic aspect of this article since this is my domain. i) The flow of the ideas is smooth, logical and consistent. ii) The literature review is sound and the articles are valid. iii) The Economics logic behind the theories of elasticity, substitution, Labor demand and Labor supply are sound. iv) The report by BLOM Invest is true. v) I have no conformity on transforming Kennan's Model for constant returns with 2 main inputs are (labor and Capital) to (Syrian Labor and Lebanese labor). The derived model in this article seems sound and is along their findings by the empirical study, however I have no theoretical back up for this model. Hence it could be considered as the value added of this research in this area.
