There are few grammatical errors and spelling 5 mistakes in this article. The manuscript is grammatically satisfactory 4. The study methods are explained clearly. 3 *There is no section that treats the methodology used for the study.* 5. The body of the paper is clear and does not contain 4 errors. There is a number of spacing errors in the manuscripts 6. The conclusions or summary are accurate and 4 supported by the content. The conclusions are robust but there is need to itemize them to look more explicit, so that recommendations can be made on the basis of that. 7. The references are comprehensive and appropriate. 3 Some of your in-text citations are not appropriate. For example: Hill et al., 2015, İtzhak et al, 2017, Anson et al., 2011, Prather et al., 2009, Madhavan et al., 2014, & Ahn et al., 2020. These authors should be cited in full in their first citation before the use of et al in subsequent citations. A number of works you cited are not included in your references: ii. a. Hill et al., 2015 b. Stevenson & Tuckwell, 2019 c. Ferri, 2007 d. Ferri, 2007 e. Blitz, Huij and Swinkels (2011) f. Mazumder, 2014 g. Tuckwell (2019) iii. Segal, (2029) is wrongly written. 2029 is still 9years away from now. See page 16 of the manuscript
