extra context of the research and even give some textbook-like basics of what adult learning is. I believe the paper would benefit greatly if the author gave more information on the current state of affairs with particularly this topic.	
<b>2. The abstract clearly presents objects, methods and results.</b>	<b>4</b>
I believe it is possible to make the abstract more concise and structured.	
<b>3. There are few grammatical errors and spelling mistakes in this article.</b>	<b>4</b>
Minor corrections are needed.

The text of the paper has references to comparisons of groups A and B but there are no calculations provided.

I mentioned above some extra misleading massive of theoretical information and lack of calculations which are altogether misleading.
