In the introduction there are a few grammatical errors – these persons refuse getting tested.</i> <i>There is the use of ‘also’ and other conjunctions such as However to start paragraphs where the thoughts are not linked.</i> <i>Paragraph two on page 5, this should be revisited – the language is contradictory</i>	
4. The study methods are explained clearly.	4
<i>(Please insert your comments)</i> <i>The method is explained but there is need for explanation on why these specific studies were selected – the justification for the choice of those and not any other.</i> <i>Revisit the review as the study focuses on Nigeria and some of the studies identified from other countries including South Africa.</i>
