There are a few grammatical errors and spelling mistakes in this article.

- Please do not use footnotes. Move your content to the main body of the text.
- Do not use proper names but their initials.
- Do not use bold or underlined terms.

I think you should keep these tips in mind for future scientific works.

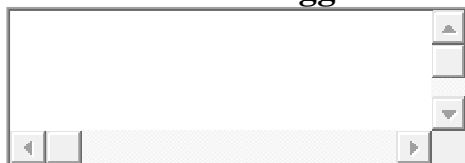

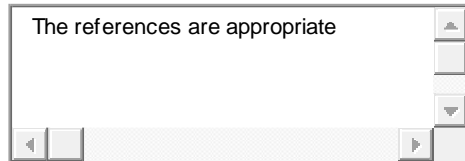

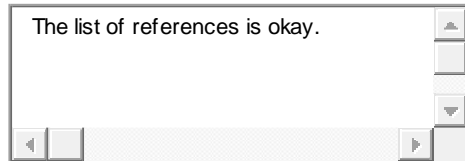
