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The methods used are clearly explained and appropriate. However, we need to review the Shanonn index formula which is not well written. In addition, the formula for calculating the number of people surveyed per neighborhood must be included.

The body of the paper is clear and does not contain errors.

The body of the manuscript is well written. the results are clear and well presented. however, the discussion needs to be reconsidered. it is necessary to discuss its own results and not the results of other authors. You should highlight your own results and provide an explanation or interpretation before comparing them to the results of other authors. In addition, beyond 2 authors, write "et al. For example N'dri, Kouassi and Ouattara, (2021) should be written N'dri et al. (2021). In addition, you must choose between "and" and "&" when citing authors in the text.

The CONCLUSION or summary is accurate and supported by the content.

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The conclusion is consistent with the content. it mentions the main results.

The list of REFERENCES is comprehensive and appropriate.

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Each in-text citation has to be included in the list of references and vice versa.

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As for the references, there is a big effort to be made. some references found in the body of the manuscript are not included in the list of references (eg Statistics Canada, 2003; Yiran, 2020; ECREEE, 2015). Others, on the other hand, are in the list of references but do not appear in the text (e.g. Zimudzi, C., Mapaura, A., Chapano, C., & Duri, W. (2013); Maishanu, HM, Bello, UB, & M, MM (2019); CEREEC (2015)). In addition, there is a lack of standardization of characters used (especially punctuation) in references. The positive note is that there are several recent references which validly support the manuscript and update it perfectly.
