La recherche est conduite selon deux axes : (1) les origines commerciales et industrielles de la souillure dans les villes ; (2) l'action des autorités urbaines. La grille de lecture proposée est, on ne peut plus, intéressante : elle permet de mettre en évidence des convergences entre la ville médiévale et le concept, très actuel, de ville durable.

Le commerce de la viande et le tannage des peaux, notamment, soulignent l'ancienneté de la "logistique des déchets", qu'ils soient commerciaux ou industriels, pointant ainsi le délicat problème de la gestion des flux de détritus.

L'auteur termine son approche par : (1) les premières interventions - ordonnances - des autorités urbaines (taxes et délocalisation des activités polluantes); (2) le changement de l'état d'esprit de la population urbaine - la peste ayant notamment permis de prendre conscience de l'importance de l'hygiène.

The methodology is intended to be reflexive in nature. The research is conducted according to two axes: (1) the commercial and industrial origins of soil in cities; (2) the action of urban authorities. The proposed reading grid is very interesting: it makes it possible to highlight convergences between the medieval city and the very current concept of sustainable city.

The meat trade and the tanning of skins, in particular, underline the age-old nature of "waste logistics", whether commercial or industrial, pointing to the delicate problem of managing waste streams.

The author concludes his approach by: (1) the first interventions - ordinances - of the urban authorities (taxes and delocalisation of polluting activities); (2) the change of the state of mind of the urban population - the plague has made it possible to become aware of the importance of hygiene.
