The Abstract is well articulated. However, methods should come after the study aim(s) and objectives as applicable.

There are a few grammatical errors and spelling mistakes in this article.

Yes, very few. Through proof reading is recommended. Kindly refer to comments made on the Manuscript.

The study METHODS are explained clearly.

Study Method is comprehensive and straight forward.

The body of the paper is clear and does not contain errors.

The major corrections are about the physical structure of the work in the aspect of paragraph, font style, and line spacing. The analysis part looks disjointed from the rest of the work in terms of formatting, it's as if it was lifted into the body of work. Content structure wise, the references in the literature area bit old. So I recommend 70% of the entire references of the work to be between 7 years and the time of the research. I think the data analysis is robust, I hope it has not been over stretched with too many data analysis tools. In depth, the authors should avoid italicizing data interpretations.

The CONCLUSION or summary is accurate and supported by the content.

The conclusion is in tandem with the body of the work.

The list of REFERENCES is comprehensive and appropriate.

I will recommend Editor's guide to the authors. In-text reference is good, but most are old and may not amount to 70% of the total reference that should be from 7 years prior to the time of the research.
