The TITLE is clear and it is adequate to the content of the article.

The title appears to be more of an article (as indeed stated in the Abstract) and not a research paper. The topic should be restated and should sound something like: The Impact of Rural Tourism on Economic Growth of Rural Residents (as stated in the Abstract).

The ABSTRACT clearly presents objects, methods, and results.

Abstract is well summarised

There are a few grammatical errors and spelling mistakes in this article.

The article has few grammatical errors and spelling mistakes

The study METHODS are explained clearly.

The Methods are not explained clearly because of the following reasons:

- 1) The first specific objective is not clear
- 2) The order of the sections
- 3) The last paragraph of the Methodology is dedicated to defining what items are and not how they have been used in the research process.
- 4) Sampling Technique is not very clear considering that the study relied heavily on primary data
- 5) It is not clear how the SWOT Analysis was conducted

The body of the paper is clear and does not contain errors.

The paper is fairly clear with some less worrisome errors

The CONCLUSION or summary is accurate and supported by the content.

The conclusion is accurate although the results have not been discussed properly as the researcher did not explain probable reasons why some variables were found to be significance or not, that is, what literature suggest on the findings.
