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

The TITLE is clear and it is adequate to the content of the article.

This title

Determinants of Children in-street Situations" can be reframed "Determinants of street children situations in Bunjumbura, Burundi: survival strategies and violence"

The ABSTRACT clearly presents objects, methods, and results.

The abstract need to be re-written to include the results. This portion of the abstract can feature in the body of the paper but should be removed from the abstract: "When the first socialization institutions fail, children are trained to live on the streets and settle there permanently. In order to cope, the child develops survival mechanisms associated with violence. Exposed to all forms of violence, victimized children become violent to survive, and the cycle of violence is fueled. "

There are a few grammatical errors and spelling mistakes in this article.

The few grammatical errors and spelling mistakes are on pages 4,7,9 and 11 as marked in the paper.

The study METHODS are explained clearly.

Yes the methods are clearly explained

The body of the paper is clear and does not contain errors.

The TITLE is clear and it is adequate to the content of the article.

The title is good and exciting. The title reflects the main topic raised in the article

The ABSTRACT clearly presents objects, methods, and results.

The abstract is good. It summarizes the main points in the article, for example, the presentation of the topic, main conclusions, and methodology.

I would suggest that after improving the summary of the article, add more insights and conclusions to the abstract.

There are a few grammatical errors and spelling mistakes in this article.

For me, the text was clear and flowing. At the same time, I think the text needs linguistic editing.

The study METHODS are explained clearly.

Yes. The methodological part is precise and detailed. I would recommend adding more information about the internal division of the interviewed children, for example, age and gender.

The body of the paper is clear and does not contain errors.

Most of the article is written in a matter-of-fact and focused manner. However, there was a lack of information on the theoretical background, why this theory was chosen, and its advantages compared to other approaches in the field.

The CONCLUSION or summary is accurate and supported by the content.

The summary, in my opinion, should also be more profound and present explanations for the research results based on the theory chosen as a framework for the research. I would recommend adding a comparative dimension to other places where the issue of street children has been examined. What distinguishes the test case mentioned in the article from other cases worldwide?
