Overall, the article is well-written and free of major grammatical errors. There are some minor instances where sentence structures could be improved for clarity, but they do not impede the understanding of the article's content. A thorough proofreading would address these small issues.

The use of QualCoder for data analysis is also well-documented, making the methodology transparent and reproducible.

The use of direct participant quotes enhances clarity and supports the findings effectively. The integration of the Gioia methodology is appropriate and contributes to methodological rigor.

However, the article could be improved by including more systematic evidence (tables, models, or quantified summaries of codes and categories) to support the narrative-based findings.
