Overall, the work is interesting, but there are several things that need to be reviewed.

- Reread the text carefully and use an appropriate academic style.
- Add the implications of the study in the summary and conclusion sections.
- When reading your manuscript, the originality of the study is not apparent.
- Add a theoretical framework and use an economic theory to contextualize the study.
- Consider the possibility of estimating your data using an econometric model.
- The discussion and conclusion sections need to be rewritten.
- Make greater use of scientific academic references in your study.
- The introduction lacks hypotheses.

A theoretical framework is needed for this type of research.

I invite you to explore the following theories:

- - the theory of supply and demand,
- - the theory of agricultural volatility,
- the theory of price transmission and information asymmetries.
