Introduction :

-(the author would benefit from deleting the last paragraph of the introduction on the conclusion, page 5;

-The author must clearly define the concept of internal displacement or internal migration in contrast to the international migration;

-the author must make the typology of internal displacements;

-The author should bring out the statistics on internal displacements in each country in order to justify their choice and to show the importance of this social phenomenon;

Suggested title : Les facteurs explicatifs des déplacements internes en Afrique centrale

-The author neglected environmental causes in the context of global warming. But, theses causes will help him to analyze a new category of internal displacement, namely : environmental displacement.
